Roadtrip to Hillsboro for training

We drove over to Hillsboro for Super Saturday, a CEF training seminar hosted by Child Evangelism Fellowship Inc. Portland Westside Chapter. The seminar was attended by staff from California, Oregon, Washington, and Idaho. We heard from John Romano, Stephen Williams, and Mark Hedinger of Culture-Bound. They spoke on the importance of evangelizing children, apologetics, ministry barriers, and building communicational bridges to other cultures, respectively.

Laurie Wheeler, one of our Committee shared this: John Romano with CEF of Maine-The three needs of children are these: First, they need someone who sees their worth in the eyes of God. Second, they need someone who will pray for them. Thirdly, they need someone who will bring them to the point of salvation. Dr. Mark Hedinger with CultureBound Ministries: "We open our mouths and God opens the hearts." Stephen Williams with Prepare the Way Ministries: In building a Biblical worldview there are two keys. First, knowledge and understanding of the reliability of the Scriptures. Secondly, building relationships by representing God accurately in all parts of our lives to all the people in our lives.


